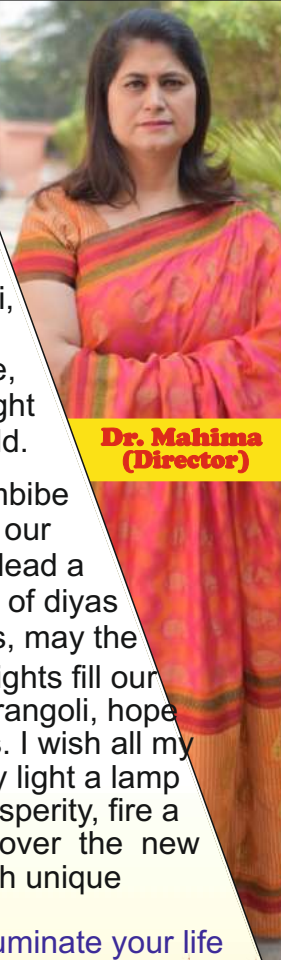
From the Director's desk
