

SYLLABUS OF CLASS: III (2023-24)



Instructions For Students

- 1. Start each class assignment with date, day and name of the lesson.
- 2 Fill the index properly side by side.
- 3. Draw finishing line after every answer.
- 4. Do correction work after every lesson.
- 5. Use pencil for geometry work, pictures, web charts and map work.
- 6. Students should avoid over-writing, cutting and tearing of pages from books and notebooks.
- 7. Write serial number on each page of the notebook.
- 8. Highlight the important content with the highlighter or coloured pencil.
- 9. Use your left hand to activate your right brain.
- 10. Practice meditation or relaxation exercise after every period.
- 11. Bring your bag according to the time-table.
- 12. Spare some time aside for self study.
- 13. Revise the classwork on daily basis.



Instructions For Parents

- 1. Parents should be particular about the respect and dignity of the teachers and management.
- 2. Keep a strict eye on the behaviour of your child. Your loving and careful attention is very necessary for your child.
- 3. Attend PTM regularly to discuss the progress of the child.
- 4. Check the almanac of your ward daily and sign it.
- 5. Give healthy diet to your child like sprouts, almonds, green vegetables, fruits and milk.
- 6. Converse in English with your child at home.
- 7. Both father and mother should come on Annual Result day.
- 8. Don't criticize the teachers in front of your child.
- 9. Spend quality time with your child.
- 10. For better communication, never rebuke your child to express himself /herself.
- 11.Don't come to school in between the school hours. If necessary, come after 1:30 p.m. to meet the teachers.
- 12. Parents should follow the school norms given in the Almanac.
- 13. Kindly refer the Almanac for all kind of information regarding school Activities.
- 14. Try to communicate with the teachers through Almanac.

Instructions For Teachers

- 1. Teachers should plan everything systematically before entering the class.
- 2. Teachers must see to it that two minutes relaxation exercises should be conducted before commencing the teaching and before dispersal.
- 3. Teachers should give the revision of class work daily, as home assignment.
- 4. English conversation is must, so teachers should take conversation classes in zero period.
- 5. It is the duty of the class teacher to conduct all the activities mentioned in the almanac.
- They have to do the checking work side by side. They should not pile up their work for the next day.
- 7. All the subject teachers should clear general concepts before the beginning of a new chapter.
- 8. Question Answers from and in between the chapter should be done by the teachers for complete knowledge.
- 9. Teacher should pay attention that long and descriptive questions should be done in the class by the students (don't dictate) and objective type questions i.e. Match the following, Fill ups etc should be given as home-work.

Subject- wise Instructions For Teachers

a) English

Tasks included in all the sections (Writing & Grammar) should be covered in the class simultaneously along with the topics. Phonics, speaking in English and use of dictionary is a must. Every new word should be underlined in the book. Teachers should lay stress on vocabulary, part of speech, sentence making and sentence structure.

b) Hindi

Poems should be read with proper expressions. Teachers should lay stress on vocabulary, Dictation, Word meanings, Part of Speech, Sentence making and sentence structure.

c) Mathematics

Fundamental concepts should be clear to the students. Basic formulas related to the topic should be explained and written in the note book before starting the exercise. Lay stress on proper use of Geometrical instruments. Maths Lab activities are mentioned at the end of every lesson. Right hand side margins must be drawn for Rough work (Calculation).

d) Social studies

Aims and objectives of the lesson should be written in notebook. Learning process will be made easy by using web charts, flow charts, diagrams etc. Important dates and events should be given in a table format. After completion of chapter, students will do the question answers related to chapters in note books in the class room. Maps will be done simultaneously after each chapter.

e) Science

Activity/Practical given in the syllabus will be conducted in the classroom/Science Lab for each and every chapter. Give more stress on diagrams, definitions, important terms, web charts and flow charts.

Instructions for Assessment

- 1. There will be two **terms Term I and Term II**, the students have to clear both the terms to be promoted to the next class.
- 2. Term I includes Cycle Test and Mid Term Examination.
 **Revision Test will be Objective based only.
- 3. Term II includes Cycle Test 2 and Final Examination.
- 4. Students are not allowed to take leave on the day of any examination as Re-Test will not be conducted. (Unless any medical reason).
- 5. Notebook Maintenance: (Weightage 5 marks for each term)
 The marks of notebook maintenance will be given before Mid Term and Final exam.
- 6. Subject Enrichment Activity: (Weightage 5 marks for each term)
 - a) Subject Enrichment Activity will be conducted **before mid term and final exam.**
 - b) It comprises of various techniques like Reading/Dictation/Debate/Public speaking etc. for language and Lab Activity/Project/Map-Work/Model Making/Field Trip etc for other subjects.
- 7. Multiple Assessment: (Weightage 5 marks for each term)
 It is a part of Internal Assessment aimed at evaluating the performance of students via observation, oral test, group work, class discussions etc.
